



How to get to Campello sul Clitunno

By train. From Rome take train to **Campello** (the station is 7 km from the Convent), or go down to **Spoletto** and call in advance for transportation to the Convent. From Florence (or Ancona) take train to **Foligno** or **Campello**, and call in advance for transportation to the Convent.

By car. Both coming from the south or north, take the (New highway) Flaminia and exit of **Campello sul Clitunno**. At the traffic lights turn right and then left (**Settecamini**). Proceed along the SP Pettino towards **Campello Alto**, crossing the center of the town. After passing through **Lenano**, bend left into **Via Benedetto Fabrizi**. At the end there is the Convent (from highway, km 8).

Given its **central location** (150 km from Rome) the Convent is very close to Spoleto, Foligno and Assisi, and is equally close to the most famous religious and tourist destinations in the region, like Perugia, Gubbio, Cortona, Cascia, Norcia, Todi, Orvieto, Rieti.

The Convent of Saints John and Peter

The Convent is located in the heart of Umbria, at 500 meters above sea level. It is the result of a merger in the 17th century of two Monasteries of cloistered Benedictine nuns (12th century - 15th century). Abolished in 1800, it was acquired by the Barnabite fathers in 1935. The Convent was restored after the earthquake of 1997 and it now operates as a *House of welcome and prayer*.

It offers hospitality to individuals and groups wishing for moments of brotherhood and pause for reflection and retreat. The Convent welcomes prayer groups and pilgrims along the *Via Francigena* of St.



Francis and other itineraries. It hosts meetings and conferences on request.

The Convent offers courses of meditation, deep prayer and fasting to help purify the body and soul. It also offers excursions and cultural activities in "sacred Umbria".

It has 28 bedrooms with bathrooms, internet connection, for a total of 45 people. There is a Church, Library, Auditorium, Dining room, an Internet point and a Relax room. Two large outdoor shaded spaces overlook a beautiful view of the Umbrian Valley.
